



#### Mental Ability


- (C)  $123456 \div 8 = 15432$   
 $P = 1, Q = 5, R = 4, S = 3$  and  $T = 2$
- (A) '1' s in the ones place  $\rightarrow$   
1, 11, 21, 31, 41, 51, 61, 71, 81, 91, 101, 111  
'1' s in the tens place  $\rightarrow$   
10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 110, 111  
'1' s in hundreds place  $\rightarrow$   
100, 101, 102, 103, 104, 105, 106, 107, 108, 109, 110, 111  
 $\therefore 12 + 12 + 12 = 36$   
Hence, **36** '1' s are used altogether.
- (B) 4 girls + 2 boys share 204 stickers  
 $\Rightarrow$  6 children share 204 stickers  
 $\therefore$  Each children had  $204 \div 6 = 34$  stickers  
 $\therefore$  3 girls + 5 boys will have  $34 \times 8$   
**= 272 stickers**
